Zozy **01/2026 – Present** *Product Engineer*

- Building an AI-powered iOS app as the sole engineer under a 2x exited founder, shipping 100+ build iterations between production versions 0.0.9 and 2.1.0 and owning the end-to-end development life cycle
- Led the company's product and engineering system from zero through product documentation and technical approaches with MCP tooling and custom AI agents that accelerated development to production in under 6 months
- Ran product discovery through 100+ user interviews, core persona validation, and flow mapping across UI/UX

AI Tech Operations, Say Adios (now Zozy) **07/2025 – 02/2026**

- Redesigned and developed an API-driven AI item classification intake engine, optimizing cycle time by 83% (30 minutes to 5 minutes) and increasing throughput by 6x
- Automated the item classification lifecycle and reduced manual work to near zero per week across categorization, logistics, and customer management
- Systematically structured all operational data into comprehensive databases across all core business functions that directly drove the pivot from a service model to a consumer app

- Established the AI Enablement Operating System to consolidate all inbound AI demand into one platform covering routing, delivery, knowledge capture, and impact measurement; projected savings of ~7 hours per request
- Ran discovery with ABX and field managers and transitioned a backlog of one-off automation ideas into a repeatable five-stage playbook with step-level baselines projecting a 35–41% reduction in cycle effort
- Won the *Strategic Impact Award* in Lumen's inaugural *AI in Action* Competition, with additional recognition across five categories including *Innovation*, *Data & Decision Intelligence*, and *Best Use of Microsoft AI*

- Diagnosed why no visibility into parent sentiment was occurring and delivered a unified feedback intelligence system, engineering six interconnected instruments across ~150 students and ~300 stakeholders

- Protected respondent anonymity by holding sole access to raw responses, distributing staff and student surveys directly, and phrasing the grades 6–12 instrument to describe conditions without naming individuals

AI Training Data Annotator

- Contracted to evaluate 500+ LLM outputs across creative writing, long-form reasoning, mathematics, and conversational dialogue
- Designed evaluation rubrics that improved response accuracy by 25%
- Analyzed outputs across reasoning and standard models, developing cross-model pattern recognition that informed a broader understanding of systematic failure modes in frontier LLMs

Personal Data Experiments **02/2026 – 08/2026**

Four experiments testing self-reported beliefs against personal data

- Tested four self-reported claims against personal records of daily clothing choice, 170,876 messages across six correspondents, 142,297 streaming plays, and recorded body and voice response. Ran all analysis on-device, from decision-tree modeling and 26-measure stylometric comparison to language-model lyric scoring

Motus **08/2026 – 09/2026**

Voice-driven strength-training app for iPhone and AirPods

- Built an iOS workout app that announces each exercise, listens for spoken sets, logs them, and times rest all through AirPods
- Tested audio and background-capture assumptions on device before writing product code; the closed-grammar set parser passes 84 spoken test phrases with 0 failures
